

North Royalton Soccer Club Board Meeting – June 5, 2012

Meeting was called to order by Pete Ragone at 6:11 PM

Members in attendance included Pete Ragone, Frank Werner, Darrin Kwiatkowski, Todd Kauppila, Rino Costa, Jackie Miranda, and Diane Harbart. Larry Zajac (adult coordinator) and Guy DiSiena (referee coordinator) were also present. Curt Keaton and Craig Zeleznik were absent.

Board reviewed the May minutes. Motion was then made by Darrin Kwiatkowski to approve the minutes, seconded by Rino Costa, and approved unanimously.

I. Treasurer's Report

II. Travel

After this year's travel tryouts, the numbers for travel are up. The club went from 18 travel teams to 22 teams; 10 boys' teams, previously 8 and 12 girls' teams, previously 10.

Jackie Miranda reported that NOGSL will be offering coaches' classes this summer. All travel coaches must take this class to get their license. North Royalton will be hosting a coaches' class this summer. Class will be held the first week in August (Friday/Saturday). Class will cost \$55. Minimum of 10 people needed for class. Some coaching changes for the 2012-2013 travel season include Alex Nagy taking over the boys U14 team, and Lori Pickering will take over the boys U10A team. All travel coaching positions have been filled

III. Scheduling

For the fall season, the board will help with the team selection process for in-house teams.

IV. Adult League

Larry Zajac reported that the adult league raised money and so they would like to use that money to enhance the Memorial soccer field. Pete and Larry will contact the school and the city to discuss this.

V. Referees

Guy DiSiena asked the club to consider paying older referees next season to walk around from field to field during games to oversee games and answer any questions that may come up. The board agreed to this.

Also, the club may look to hold their referee class earlier in order to try to get a greater attendance. Club will look to move the class to January or February.

VI. New Business

An incident occurred at an in-house game during Soccer Days. Pete is getting information from all involved and witnesses. Board will address the matter at the next meeting if needed.
