

North Royalton Soccer Club Trustees Meeting – June 5, 2012

Meeting was called to order by Pete Ragone at 7:41 PM

Members in attendance included 9 board members, and 25 trustees. See the secretary's minutes for complete list of attendees.

I. Treasurer's Report

The 2012 NRSC budget was passed out to all the trustees and Todd Kauppila went over some of the items and answered any questions. A motion to accept the 2012 budget was made by Mike Franko and seconded by Marty Matz. The budget was approved unanimously.

II. Travel

All rosters for the 2012-2013 travel teams will be posted at Heasley but the week of June 11, 2012.

All travel teams must fill out AASL and OYSAN registration forms with player pictures and return them to Darrin or Jackie as soon as possible.

All coaches and assistant coaches must try to get their licencing done this summer. North Royalton will hold a coaches' class the first Friday and Saturday in August. See OYSAN website for more information. All coaches will be reimbursed for the class by the soccer club.

III. Equipment

All equipment was to be turned in at the meeting. Anyone not at the meeting can contact Rino Costa to arrange drop off of equipment.

NRSC has switched from the black and gold uniform to purple and gold. All newly formed travel teams will get the new uniform. Existing teams can decide when they want to get them. Uniforms can be ordered through Gearin' Up in North Royalton.

IV. Scheduling

All in-house coaches must turn in their player rating sheets to Frank Werner. Rating sheets used to form teams next year. Forms can be emailed to Frank.

V. President's Report

1. Footskills went very well for the in-house teams this spring. The numbers grew each week. The last week Pete estimated that about 225-240 kids participated.

Footskills will continue in the fall and will be open to both in-house and travel players. More information will be provided at a later meeting.

2. A winter league at the Fieldhouse for in-house teams is being considered. Teams would be co-ed.
3. There were a few coaching issues this spring. Pete asked all coaches to please be respectful to the referees and players.
4. Travel numbers are up for the 2012-2013 season. The club went from 18 travel teams to 22 teams (2 new teams in both the boys and girls)
5. The soccer club has been working with the city to have the old fence on the east side of Heasley removed and the city has agreed. The club will replace it with a new one hopefully in July. Pete received 3 quotes for the fence: Sterling at \$13,980, American Fence at \$14,985, and Budget Fence at \$21,750. Bruce DiFrancisco made a motion to approve \$15,000 for the new fence, seconded by Mike Franko, and approved unanimously.
6. Karen Grasso, the registrar, resigned and Craig Zeleznik volunteered to take the position until the November elections. Mike Franko motioned to accept Craig as the new registrar, seconded by Bruce DiFrancisco, and unanimously approved.

Pete motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Darrin Kwiatkowski. Meeting adjourned at 8:24 PM.
