March 7th, 2009

Costs involved:

Must register online (<http://www.ohnrefs.org/join.htm>) or bring in check for \$65.00 made out to Ohio North Referee Development
Must also bring in separate check for \$25.00 made out to North Royalton Soccer Club

This class is to register for new referees at the recreation level (Grade 9, Blue Badge) and must be re-registered every year to keep active.

For existing referees (Grade 9):

March 21st, 2009

Must bring in separate check for \$25.00 made out to North Royalton Soccer Club

Must also do one of the following:

Must register online (<http://www.ohnrefs.org/join.htm>) or bring in check for \$65.00 made out to Ohio North Referee Development (for existing Grade 9 referees that are upgrading to Grade 8.

OR

If you took and passed the March 7th, 2009 class and want to upgrade to Grade 8, bring in a separate blank check made out to Ohio North Referee Development (last year they charged only a \$5.00 fee due to the already \$65 charge of the previous class, but they have not told me what the charge will be this year).

This class is to register existing or new Grade 9 referees to Grade 8 status. This must also be re-registered every year to keep active.

Grade Level Differences:

Grade 9 (blue badge)

This gives the referee the qualifications to referee recreation level of play in any City from the U6 to U14 level. NRSC will not allow rookie referees to referee alone for the first season. We also try to keep referees at levels of 2 years under their age, for example a 10 year old referee will only be allowed to referee U8 games. As the referee gets older, they are moved up to older games. This is organized by the NRSC.

Grade 8 (black badge)

This gives the referee the qualifications to referee recreation and travel level of play in any City from the U6 to U14 level. NRSC DOES NOT organize this; the website (<http://www.gcsoa.com>) will tell you how to get on the travel list. Please note that all travel games are a one referee system.

The \$25.00 NRSC fee goes to help pay for the instructors, the exam fee and the lunch provided.
The \$65.00 fee is for the referee association and their expenses.
